He also is an instructor for Newport Beach Fire Explorer program in which he instructs on Engine Company operations and fire attack.

Mr. Sutherland has been on numerous Campaign Fires in California working as an Engine Captain. Throughout his career he has responded to over 300 fires and has been the assigned investigator for over 50 fires. He has assisted on 100 investigations throughout his career in the fire service.
