In 2003, she transitioned from active duty to the USAF Reserves where she worked 10 years for the Air Force Academy. Upon her retirement, she was appointed by Governor Brown to be the California State Director for the Selective Service System. She served in this GS-15 role from 2013 to 2016. In addition, Julie has been a full-time commercial airline pilot for Jetblue Airways since 2003.

Upon her military retirement, Julie decided to pursue a lifelong passion with the fire service in addition to her airline pilot career. She obtained an A.S in Fire Science, completed a Firefighter Academy with the highest academic score, and subsequently volunteered as a Reserve Firefighter with CALFIRE CZU where she earned her California Firefighter I certification.
